#### Concordia Lutheran Church Council Meeting April 11, 2023

President Taylor Sannes called the meeting of Concordia's Church Council to order on April 11, 2023 @ 7:05 pm. Those present were Pastor Dan Morton, Taylor Sannes, Nick Neibauer, Carol Petersen, Karl Tollefson, Kristina Sandberg, Liz Lisburg, and Sue Lindberg.

Taylor opened with devotions from Acts 22:8.

<u>The Secretary's Report</u> The secretary's report was emailed, reviewed and accepted (Carol/Nick) M/S/A. <u>Treasurer's and Financial Secretary's Report</u> The treasurer's report was accepted as presented (Sue/Nick) M/S/A. <u>Pastor's Report</u>: Easter Sunday service was special with a full church. Pastor Dan is meeting with a bishop this week and April's pulpit supply is covered.

#### Committee Reports:

<u>Management and Finance</u>: (Nick) The gutters are needing cleaning. An estimate for gutter covers will be obtained. A lengthy discussion was held on the options for the church parsonage with the congregational meeting and vote this Sunday. The congregation will vote on the three options for the parsonage. <u>Outreach</u>: (Mackinzie) Mackinzie was absent. Our Facebook page and website need Concordia's 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary added for the event coming up Sept. 30<sup>th</sup> and Oct. 1<sup>st</sup>.

<u>Home and church Life: (Liz)</u> The Easter brunch with fruit and snacks served approximately 35 people following services. The Senior Sunday will be held May 21<sup>st</sup> @ 9:30 am, with 13 Seniors being recognized and receiving their quilts. Coffee and cake will be served after services.

Education: (Tina) The Sunday School kids sang with the choir on Palm Sunday. Vacation Bible School is scheduled for June 11<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup>. Tina has found an online Bible Study with "Right Now Media" for children through adults and Pastor Dan will review these series. Bids were received for painting the Sunday School rooms, hallways, chapel, for \$2,475.00 and the kitchen for \$350.00 from Kylie's Painting. Plans to remove the chalkboards and replace them with white boards have been made, with Tom Oftedahl and Kurt Larson helping. A motion was made and seconded (Sue/Karl) to price and purchase paint, remove and replace the chalk boards with white boards, paint the Sunday School rooms, hallways, chapel, and kitchen using Kylie's Painting Service. (M/S/A). Dorothy Schuschke has offered to donate funds in memory of Art Schuschke for the white boards. Monies are available from the Maintenance Fund to use as well for the expenses. Daycare: (Lori) Lori was absent. Karl informed the council that Andrea hopes to apply for grant monies to pay for wood chips or rubber chips for the playground area of the daycare.

Worship: (Carol) Nothing new with worship services.

<u>Old Business</u>: This Sunday following church services, a congregational meeting will be held to vote on 3 options regarding plans for Concordia's current parsonage. There will be a two-part vote to eliminate one of the options, which are to

1) repair and remodel the current parsonage, 2) purchase a new parsonage, or 3) build a new structure for the parsonage.

The second vote will then decide which of the two remaining options, the church council will pursue.

<u>New Business</u>: Discussion was held on establishing a Maintenance and Finance subcommittee, a Parsonage Committee, which would be ongoing for consistency and carry over, year to year, for semi-annual inspections, and providing information for needed repairs and upkeep on the parsonage.

Adjournment motion was made @9:00 pm. (Nick/Carol) M/S/A followed by the Lord's Prayer.

Words for Justice in several languages used in the region

Recently I participated in the annual Lutheran Communion in Southern Africa (LUCSA) Christian Education Coordinators Consultation held in Johannesburg. The theme for the consultation was "Justice for Life" based on Micah 6:8.

A central objective of the consultation was to reflect on the theme of justice through the "Reformation lens," of justification by grace through faith, and how this shapes the way we hear, read, teach, worship and live out the Gospel in our respective churches and communities in the LUCSA region. Participants reflected on the concept of "intersectional justice" which looks at the ways in which systems of inequality based on gender, ethnicity, racism, poverty, disability and class "intersect" reinforcing discrimination and injustice. The African concept of "ubuntu," which means "a person is a person through other persons," was also seen as central to achieving justice. There were devotions, Bible studies, presentations and discussions on Justice and Reconciliation, Child Rights in urch and Society. Economic and Climate Justice.
