

Concordia Lutheran Church Council Meeting

December 10, 2024

President Elaine Erdahl called Concordia's Church Council meeting to order @ 7:00 pm on December 10, 2024. Those present were Elaine Erdahl, Dan Morton, Tina Sandberg, Nick Neibauer-Adams, Salome Hansen, Karl Tollefson, Brandon Neibauer-Adams, Mackinzie Burke, Liz Lisburg, Sue Lindberg and Belinda Fjeld from the Parish Board. Brandon opened with devotions from 1st Corinthians 5:12-13.

Secretary's Report from November was reviewed via email and accepted as presented. (Nick/Tina) M/S/A.

Treasurer's and Financial Secretary's Report: The Thanksgiving Offering (\$841) will be given to the Food Shelf and Care and Share. A Certificate of Deposit was renewed at the Red River State Bank @ 4.5% interest. A motion by Brandon, seconded by Nick and passed to accept the report as presented. M/S/A.

Pastor's Reports: Pastor Dan reported that pulpit supply will be needed starting in January as Pastor Darrell Morton is retiring at the end of December. The synod is aware of the need for help in January and February. A rotation schedule will be planned for all the churches.

Parish Report: (Belinda) Belinda reports the Parish Board has approved the budget for 2025. Concordia's payment to the Parish will remain approximately the same. The Parish Board has forgiven three months' payments from each congregation this past year. Starting in January, Jamie Morvig will be getting paid a salary as our SAM, Synod Authorized Minister. There is planning underway for a Virtual Church Directory and two volunteers will be needed from each congregation to help with submitting photos. The Call Committee has interviewed two candidates for pastor without success yet.

Committee Reports: Home & church Life: (Liz) Liz is planning a Bingo Night on January 8th from 6:00 to 7:30 with the Parish Youth helping serve Taco in a Bag and floats.

Outreach: (Mackinzie) Concordia is participating in the "Angel Tree Program" and working in connection with the school for 57 children in need. We are happy to report that "angels" have stepped up to give gifts to others and gifts will be picked up by December 22nd. There were seven families who joined Concordia church on Sunday November 24th and gift bags were given to each family.

Parsonage: The work on blueprints for the kitchen and measuring for cabinets continues.

Education: (Tina) The Children's Christmas program will be December 15th during church services, including 50 plus children. A woman's bible study entitled "Risen Motherhood." Gospel Hope for Everyday Moments will be held the 1st and 3rd Wednesdays beginning January 15th at 7:00 p.m. A guy's bible study could be held during Sunday School if there is interest.

Daycare: (Brandon) A two year lease for the Daycare was reviewed for 2025 and 2026. A motion was made by Sue, seconded by Nick, and passed approving this lease. M/S/A Branson will present the contract to Andrea for signing.

Worship: (Jami) The Christmas Eve service will be held December 24th at Concordia at 4:00 p.m. The Christmas offering will go to the Area Food Shelf. We request that checks be made out to Concordia and indicate on the memo line to be given to the Area Food Shelf. Beginning the 2nd and 3rd Sundays in January, worship will be a more contemporary service including new hymns.

Management and Finance: (Nick) Much discussion was held on the proposed budget for 2025. A motion was made by Karl, seconded by Mackinzie and passed to increase Jon Christianson's salary to \$19,000 annually. M/S/A

A motion was made by Nick, seconded by Tina to increase the monthly salary to Taylor Sannes to \$250.

M/S/A Concordia will continue to support Pathways and invite them do a presentation to our congregation to encourage our youth to attend camp. Tina will check on this.

A motion was made by Nick, seconded by Sue to accept the budget as amended for 2025, which passed. M/S/A

Old Business: Brandon is meeting with the Nominating Committee in preparation for 2025 and searching for volunteers. Please consider this opportunity to serve our church.

New Business: A date for the Annual Meeting was set for January 26,2025 following worship.

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made and passed @ 9:10 pm. (Elaine/Tina). M/S/A Concordia's next council meeting will be January 14th, 2025. The meeting closed with the Lord's Prayer. Submitted by Sue Lindberg, Secretary

Pastor's Report: Dan reported that as of the end of year Darrell will be stepping down. Parish approved schedule to go to a 4 service Sunday Schedule. Treasurer's report: Hunger appeal we collected \$1600 for world hunger and \$705 for local. They are looking into the Insurance policy to see if we can save some money. The annual premium has been paid. Colleen and Teri are getting all the year end information together for the annual report and budget. **Vice President's report:** John reported the online directory will be implemented in 2025. We need an Action representative from LN to make sure the pictures and information gets in. Review of the 2025 Budget completed. John reminded us that the local food shelf must purchase items from the Food Bank. If we look to donate to local food shelf, we need to put in memo use as needed.

Deacon's: Heidi and Joan reported they are getting everything lined up for the Candlelight Christmas eve service. Looking to add a Circle of Light to the service.

Trustees: Jim reported the plumbing in the parsonage has been completed. Flooring will be the next project. Batteries needed for the fire alarms. Thermometer is in front window. Jim will install the alarms in the parsonage as new requirement for insurance. Basement chairs at Church have been taken care of. **Education:** Kristen reported the Christmas program will be December 15th, 11:00 service. Group 2 in charge of lunch. Sunday School will be at 10:00am January.

The Faaberg Council met on Sunday, December 8, 2024 at 7pm in the church basement.

Attending were Peggy Ystenes, Jeff Gullickson, Tony Grieve, Steve Gullickson, Brad Hanson, Sue Knutson, Brenda Grunhovd, Vickie Thronson, Dave Harstad and Les Krogstad.

Peggy called the meeting to order. Motion by Sue, second by Steve to approve the agenda. Carried

Vickie read the Secretaries Report. Corrections were that Mid-Valley Electric removed the lights under the balcony and replaced them with can lights. One light was used in the Balcony, one is a spare. The \$1,212.99 was for a new sewage pump, not sewer pumping. Sewer pumping was not needed. With the corrections, motion by Jeff second by Brenda to approve minutes. Carried.

Jeff gave the Parish report. The Call process is continuing. Because Pastor Darrell is retiring, the Parish has come up with a new schedule for the first 3 months of 2025. The 4 country churches will alternate not having a pastor one Sunday a month. Worship times for the 4 were also changed starting January 1. This leaves Pastor Dan and SAM Jamie Morvig with 2 services each Sunday. Some options for these open Sunday's were discussed. The Parish is also looking into having a digital Parish directory instead of a printed book.

Upcoming events to note: Christmas eve service at Faaberg will be at 4pm; Annual meeting January 19, 2025 after 11AM service; First Communion Classes February 23, with First communion Service Sunday March 2, 2025.

The Nominating committee has begun reviewing positions to be filled at the January Annual meeting.

Old Business: Brad reported that Herman Miller had done the soffit repairs. He also found some openings in the bell tower and plugged them.

Jeff said he had done weed spraying and cleaned up some shrubs.

New Business: It was brought up that having new hymnals would be nice. The words to the songs printed in the weekly bulletins are from the new Red hymnals. Sue had checked and estimated each hymnal would cost \$30.00 After some discussion Sue made a motion to purchase 20 Red hymnals for \$30 each. Seconded by Jeff, carried.

The Parish office has room for the Faaberg Record Book. Currently the book has been kept up by Peggy, and is in the Faaberg safe. Going forward the Parish office would update the records. Motion by Les, second by Dave to move the record book to the Parish office.

Peggy gave the treasurer's report. Peggy noted she had received a letter from Red River Bank notifying us of a new monthly fee for ACH. After some discussion Vickie made a motion to move our Checking and Savings accounts from Red River Bank to Ultima Bank. Second by Sue, carried. Tony made a motion to transfer some money from the Hodous Funds savings account to the checking account. Second by Brenda, carried.

We worked on the 2025 budget. Motion by Dave, second by Tony to approve the treasurer's report and the proposed 2025 budget. Carried.

Having no further business Steve made a motion to adjourn, second by Dave. Carried
