Pastor Notes

St. Patrick's Day is celebrated annually on March 17, the anniversary of his death in the fifth century. St. Patrick's Day 2025 will take place on Monday, March 17. The Irish have observed this day as a religious holiday for over 1,000 years. On St. Patrick's Day, which falls during the Christian season of Lent, Irish families would traditionally attend church in the morning and celebrate in the afternoon. Lenten prohibitions against the consumption of meat were waived and people would dance, drink and feast on the traditional meal of Irish bacon and cabbage. Yum? Do you suppose they drank green beer?

St Patrick was born in Britian, kidnapped and was brought to Ireland as a slave at the age of 16. He later escaped and was credited for brining Christianity to the people in Ireland. In the centuries following St.Patrick's death (believed to have been on March 17, 461), the mythology surrounding his life became ever more ingrained in the Irish culture: Perhaps the most well-known legend of St. Patrick is that he explained the Holy Trinity (Father, Son and Holy Spirit) using the three leaves of a native Irish clover, the shamrock.

In the New Testament, the month of March is linked to the season of Lent, a period of forty days of fasting, prayer, and penance leading up to Easter Sunday. Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, March 5th and ends on Holy Saturday, the day before Easter. This solemn season is a time for reflection, repentance, and spiritual renewal as Christians prepare to commemorate the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Moreover, the month of March serves as a reminder of the importance of faith, hope, and perseverance in the face of adversity. Just as the Israelites were delivered from destruction during Purim and Jesus triumphed over death at Easter, March symbolizes the victory of light over darkness, good over evil, and life over death. It is a time to draw strength from the stories of courage, redemption, and salvation found in the Bible and to renew our commitment to living out the principles of love, mercy, and justice.

As we journey through the month of March, let us embrace the lessons of the past, the challenges of the present, and the promises of the future. May we find inspiration in the scriptures, comfort in prayer, and guidance in the teachings of Jesus. March is not just a time on the calendar but an opportunity to deepen our relationship with God, strengthen our faith, and share the message of hope and salvation with others. Let us walk in the footsteps of the faithful who have gone before us, trusting in the providence of God and the power of His grace to sustain us in all circumstances. During this Lenten season we will gather as one, joining our other congregations in unity with each other at Concordia. We will be able to film our Lenten services for the shut ins, those in our nursing homes and assisted living. May this season of Lent be your "Lucky Charm"! Blessings, Jamie Morvig SAM
