Brandon opened with devotions from Matthew 11:5.

Secretary's Report from February was reviewed via email and accepted as presented. (Jami/Tina) M/S/A.

<u>Treasurer's and Financial Secretary's Report</u>: A six month CD at Red River State Bank will be taken out @ 4.25% interest. A motion (Sue/Jerad) to move the Money Market account into a six month certificate of deposit bearing 4.25% interest was made and passed. A motion (Jerad/Sue) was made to close out the pastor's discretionary account for emergencies \$1,350.00 which Pastor Dan does not use. These monies will be added to the Certificate of Deposit @ 4.25% interest from the Money Market Account totaling \$45,297.37. Reports were given and accepted as reported (Jami/John) M/S/A. <u>Pastor's Reports:</u> Lenten Services will be held at Concordia for United in Christ Lutheran Parish beginning Ash Wednesday, March.5, 2025 at 7:00 p.m. and Easter Sunday is April 20th. A pastor or SAM will lead church services on Easter Sunday in all 5 parish churches.

Parish Report: (Verna) The monthly rent owed to Concordia from the Parish for use of the offices and building is due. Committee Reports:

Home & Church Life: (Anna) Anna was absent.

<u>Outreach</u>: (Janadee) Janadee is checking into using a powerpoint presentation for updates on church events and location as a bulletin board.

<u>Parsonage</u>: Plans are in place to start the demolition process of the kitchen in April if the cupboards are ready to install. Pastor Dan reported they plan to stay with his parents when the kitchen remodel starts.

Education: (Tina) Starting April 6th, there will be eight preschool children starting Sunday School. The Sunday School will be singing March 30th and also on Mother's Day. Vacation Bible School will be held June 8th to the 12th.

Daycare: (Verna) Nothing new to report.

<u>Worship</u>: (Jami) A big thank you to all who are participating with worship and Lenten services. Lenten services continue with all the parish churches helping to serve coffee afterwards. Discussion about the microphone feedback and if new sound boards are needed was tabled.

<u>Management and Finance</u>: (Jared) Loren continues with the plans to remodel the parsonage kitchen starting in April, when the cabinets are ready. The leaking bell tower repair needs further investigation as the person who had been contacted is no longer able to complete this repair. Hourly rates from two electricians were received for any upcoming work for the church as Brian Downs is retiring. Quotes for 2 recessed tv screens were obtained from Site on Sound in Fargo, ND. This was tabled for the time being.

<u>Old Business</u>: Brandon read a thank you note from the Fertile Area Food Shelf for the gift (\$4,557.50) from UCLP Thanksgiving and Christmas offerings.

<u>New Business</u>: A motion was made, seconded and passed (John/Jami) to reimburse Dean Rasmussen for the new drum set for the worship band. A discussion was held on creating a list of charities/memorials for members to use, including but not inclusive of cemetery, quilting, choir, building/parsonage, and technology needs. This information will be supplied in the upcoming bulletins.

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made and passed @ 8:34 p.m. (Sue/Tina). M/S/A Concordia's next council meeting will be April 8th, 2025. The meeting closed with the Lord's Prayer.


