Secretary's Report from March was reviewed via email and accepted as presented. (John/Tina) M/S/A.

<u>Treasurer's and Financial Secretary's Report</u>: John reported he has the new Certificates of Deposit and will be kept in the office safe. Dean Rasmussen has been paid for the new drum set for the church. Reports were given and accepted as reported (Jared/Sue) M/S/A.

<u>Parsonage</u>: The plan is to start the demolition process of the parsonage kitchen after Easter. New appliances and flooring will be needed. The new kitchen cabinets have been ordered.

<u>Education</u>: (Tina) Five preschool children started Sunday School on April 6th. The Sunday School will be singing on Mother's Day. Vacation Bible School will be held June 8th to the 12th and supplies have been ordered with the potential for 70 students. VBS is open to all area students.

The ongoing operation of the cemetery would not be sustainable without all these important gifts.

<u>Plan Ahead</u>. These words cannot be good news coming from the cemetery president. Yet after 5 years of doing this work, that is the single best advice I can offer to people my age and older in regards to making things clear and stress-free for your family. It is quick and easy to get started and even decide on final arrangements. Please contact me for more information.

Memorial Day. Typically, the cemetery sees the most visitors around the end of May and it is amazing to see all the decorations left to honor the memories of those who have passed. We greatly appreciate our visitors and strive to have a freshly-mown facility for that weekend. Please remember that all décor brought into the cemetery is temporary - as stated on the Rules Plaque at the cemetery entrance. After July 15th, we will discard any decorations, except healthy potted plants, that impede with mowing and trimming. Thank you for your cooperation.

Helping Out. We have repaired, lifted, and cleaned about 400 gravestones in both cemeteries in the past few years. There are more to do, but many markers that just require minor edging to remove excess sod will not be included in that project. If you are able, we ask you to try gently trimming around the marker when you are out for a visit.

Archive. Creating a computer database for the cemetery is a big and ongoing project. We are also saving funeral bulletins for our archive; if you have any bulletins or clippings to donate, we would be grateful to add them to our collection.
