Welcome, Pastor Katie!

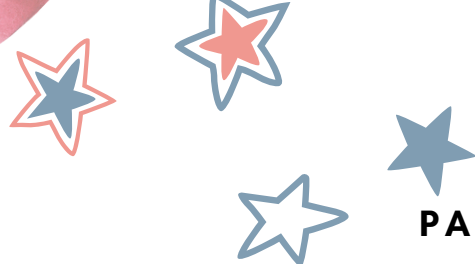
Hi Everyone!

Brandon opened with devotions from Ephesians 5:15-20.

Secretary's Report: The May report was reviewed via email and accepted as presented (Verna/Jared) M/S/A.

Treasurer's and Financial Secretary's Report: Reports were given and accepted as reported (Sue/Anna) M/S/A. The remaining bills for the remodeling project will be paid.

Pastor's Reports: Pastor "Katie" Ohren-Shipman will be in the office tomorrow, June 18th and will be preaching at Trinity next Sunday, June 22nd. She will be ordained June 28th at Bethesda Lutheran Church in Moorhead and her installation to UCLP will be upcoming.

Parish Report: (Verna) The Parish board is working on Pulpit Supply. The board will be handling the expenses of moving the new Pastor Katie Ohren-Shipman to Fertile and with the expenses of the Installation Services with the meal being catered. Jeff Krogstad will be speaking at the Polk County Fair Church Services. The offering will be donated to Care and Share and the Fertile Food Shelf.

Committee Reports:

Home & Church Life: (Anna) Nothing new to report.

Outreach: (Janadee) The new announcements TV board in the narthex is looking good. Keep Janadee updated on information to be shared.

A golf membership to the Fertile Golf Course was given to Pastor Katie as a welcome gift.

Parsonage: The kitchen remodel project is complete and looks beautiful. There are pictures on the announcement TV board in the narthex.

Education: (Tina) Vacation Bible School, "True North" was this past week with 64 kids attending and a special guest "Jesus" also visited. Thank you to all those who helped to make VBS such a successful fun time sharing the love of Jesus.

Daycare: (Verna) A motion by John, seconded by Jared and passed to purchase rubber mats for the daycare and will be paid for from the Daycare fund.

Worship: (Jami) Speaking the Kyrie instead of singing it during worship will be used in the summer months. Discussion was held on the Garden Valley streaming service which has been problematic, and Garden Valley has been contacted.

Management and Finance: (Jared) The upcoming mission trip to Costa Rica in June/July has been well supported with all the needed items donated. Thank you to everyone who helped with this endeavor and we pray for a safe and successful trip for all those going. A parsonage committee is recommended for regular monitoring of the parsonage.

Old Business: A motion (via email on June 10th) by Jared, seconded by Janadee passed to have the carpets cleaned and will be completed Wednesday. The bid to clean the carpets was for \$625.

New Business: A motion to donate \$1000 to the NWMN Spring Appeal was made and passed (Jami/Tina). M/S/A The council reviewed and reaffirmed the past practice of not lending out tables and chairs for events. This is done to maintain the integrity of church furniture to ensure durability, aesthetics, and lasting use. The motion was made by Jami and seconded by Verna and passed to continue this practice. The old wooden chairs in the Fair Stand will be disposed of. Concordia's chairs may be used for the Fair Stand as needed.

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made and passed @ 8:55 p.m. (Jami/Jared). M/S/A
Concordia's next council meeting will be August 12th, 2025.

5. We will skip our July council meeting.

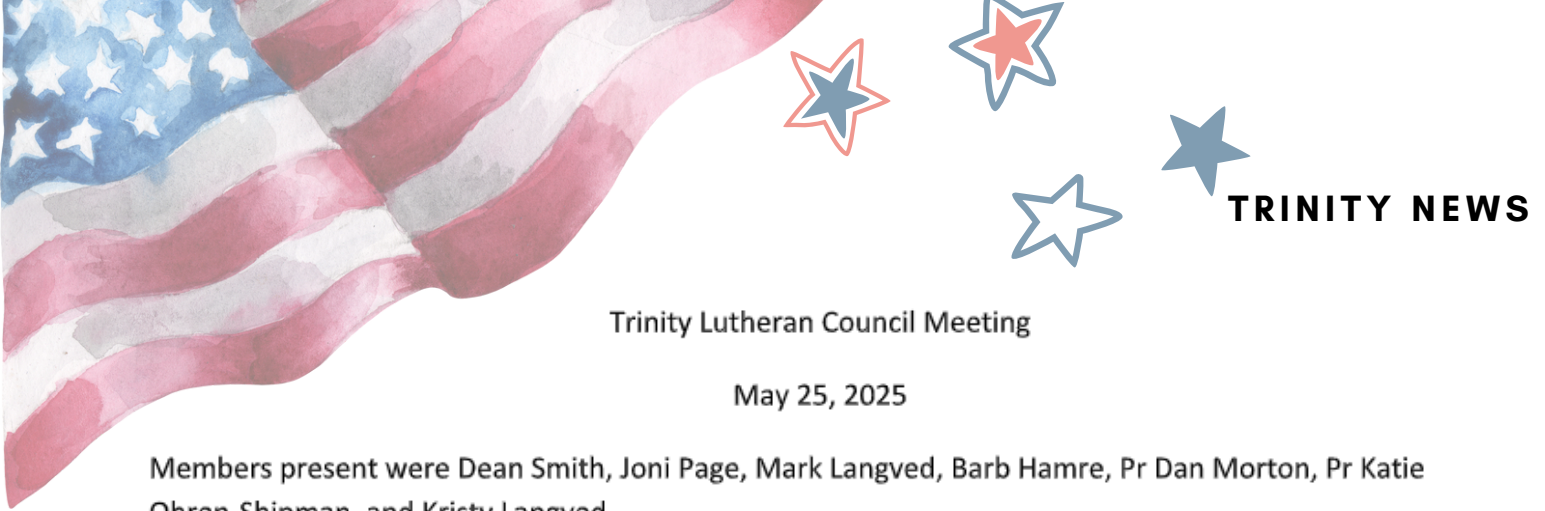
Other Business
