It's been a while since I have sat down and written one of these things, but I was thinking to myself the other day that our Parish is lacking a key resource for the month of October. The faithful have been waiting for pastoral guidance on a subject that becomes more relevant every passing day, and so I present to you a short list of movies that I plan on watching this October for my annual horror marathon. Remember readers, I only provide this service because of the great demand that I have just recently become aware of. I advise the faint of heart to read no further, but for those who choose to read on, prepare yourselves for the spookiest list of movies ever compiled by a Lutheran Pastor in Northwest Minnesota.

- Abbott & Costello Meet Frankenstein (1948) This was the first Dracula movie I ever saw, the
  first Frankenstein movie I ever saw, and the first Wolfman movie I ever saw. My addiction to both
  monsters and silliness starts here.
