Brandon opened with devotions from Job 21:1,17-34.

<u>Secretary's Report</u> from October was reviewed via email and accepted as presented. (Jared/John) M/S/A

<u>Treasurer's and Financial Secretary's Report</u>: A motion by Sue, seconded by Anna passed to accept the reports as presented. M/S/A Jared motioned, seconded by Jami and passed to deposit ten thousand dollars to the general fund from the Concordia Fair Stand and three thousand dollars to be given to WELCA. Pastor's Report: Pastor Katie reported that confirmation has been completed for all 5 congregations. Kari Morvig will be the new SAM of UCLP. Lindi Christianson and Theresa Sandness have contracted with other Parishes, Lindi on a 6-month contract and Theresa on 3 months. Kari will start on a regular schedule starting in January, she will be preaching on Christmas Eve. Each of the 4 churches that have Christmas Eve service will have pulpit fill.
